Biographical Sketch:

Reynold J. Carlson died in Dallas of pneumonia on March 3, 1937, at the age of 25 while he was a student at Dallas Theological Seminary. Mr. Carlson was from Duluth, MN, and was buried there. The Seminary Bulletin indicates he had attended Duluth Junior College and Wheaton College. Carlson was the third DTS student to die while enrolled.
