

SEARCHING AND BROWSING FOR BIBLE PASSAGES IN THE ATLA RELIGION DATABASE

Here are two ways to lookup a Bible passage in the Atla database.

1. Use the SR (scripture reference) field code (uppercase) and the following format.
SR "John 3"
SR "Corinthians, 1st 10"
2. Alternatively, select "Atla Scripture Search" in the lower left column. The middle column will display the Atla Scripture Search form. Provide a name for book of the bible (John in the image) and press enter. A list of chapter numbers will appear. Browse the list. Select a chapter (and verse if you wish). In the lower right, click "Add to search" to insert the search statement into the searchbox. SR "John 3:16" is the example in the top middle of the screen.
